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INBP has been developed to respond to the crisis in UK Healthcare staffing shortages (currently 40000 nursing vacancies)

This is demonstrated in the government's decision to place Healthcare roles in the Shortage Occupation List, and to create a new visa route called the Health and Care Visa designed to encourage overseas Healthcare workers to come to the UK to take up jobs.

Activate Learning International in cooperation with Royal Berkshire Hospital, Berkshire has created the INBP to bridge the gap for qualified nurses from overseas to train as NHS staff in UK.



About the course

The course delivers the elements required to qualify to work as a nurse in the UK; Objective Structured Clinical Examination (OSCE), Computer Based Test, Occupational English Test (OET) and other modules designed together with the Royal Berkshire Hospital Trust (RBHT) Delivery is 100% online through the Academic and Professional Studies Faculty (AAPS).

The programme is six months, candidates receive weekly "live" lessons, as well as guided self study, examination practice and personal tutor support throughout. Learners can determine their pace of study to fit with their work and personal commitments.

Assessment on this programme is through a combination of exams (30%) and coursework (70%) including essays, presentations, examinations and a portfolio of evidence

Employment in the UK (either in public or private healthcare) as a registered nurse on NHS salary band 5.
